HOW TO BECOME A MEMBER OF HYP

PRINCIPLES

- ✚ HYP is a place where Members can enjoy themselves in a safe environment.
- ✚ It is a place where Members and Leaders treat each other with mutual respect.

HOW TO BECOME A MEMBER

- ✚ Read the Rules of Membership and make sure you understand them
- ✚ If you decide that the Rules of Membership are acceptable to you, ask a parent or carer to complete and sign the attached Membership Application form
- ✚ The completed and signed form should be returned to the HYP Duty Manager at Hill Park Baptist Church during any HYP session.
- ✚ The HYP Leadership will consider your application for membership, and will advise if you cannot be accepted at this time.

HYP RULES OF MEMBERSHIP

ELIGIBILITY

- HYP is open to those attending secondary school years 7-11.

PRINCIPLES

- HYP is a place where Members can enjoy themselves in a safe environment.
- It is a place where Members and Leaders treat each other with mutual respect
- It is a place where the authority of Leaders is recognised.

UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOUR

A Member will receive a verbal warning from a Leader for:

- The use of language or other behaviour which in the opinion of a Leader is abusive, offensive or threatening.
- Any threat of physical violence or intimidation toward anyone.
- Any behaviour which in the opinion of a Leader:
 - is likely to endanger that Member or any other person; or
 - is likely to cause damage to the Premises, equipment or furniture
- Smoking, other than in Designated Area at the back of the Church building
- Loitering in the area in front of the Church building
- Creating a disturbance or behaviour that will bring the club into disrepute.

EJECTION

A Member will be removed from the Premises for:

- Any recurrence of any of the above after having received a verbal warning from a Leader earlier in that session.
- Refusing to leave the premises when asked to do so by a Leader.
- Appearing to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs in the opinion of any Leader.
- Any actual physical violence towards any person
- Any actual damage caused to the Premises, equipment or furniture
- Taking or misusing any equipment or furniture or the belongings of others
- Entering the Premises without permission
- Challenging any decision of a Leader

No refund of any Entry Fee will be paid to anyone excluded from the Premises.

EXCLUSION

- The HYP Director may decide to exclude any Member from the Club for persistent unacceptable behaviour. The period of such exclusion will be appropriate to the seriousness and persistence of such behaviour.
- Whilst excluded, the Member is not permitted to enter the Premises, or to take part in any Club activities.
- The period of such exclusion may be increased by the HYP Director in the event of any unacceptable behaviour on the part of the excluded Member which takes place within or in the vicinity of the Premises during such exclusion.

ENTRY

- The full Entry Fee is payable in cash upon entry to the Club
- No admission will be allowed during the last 30 minutes of any session
- The Club may need to be evacuated for Health & Safety reasons at any time
- No refund of Entry Fee will be payable in the event of a necessary evacuation

REFUSAL OF ENTRY

Entry to the Premises will be refused to any Member who:

- fails to make payment in full of the Entry Fee
- in the opinion of any Leader appears to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- has been told to leave the Premises during the current Session
- has previously left the Premises during the current Session
- is currently excluded from the Club

APPEAL

Any Member can appeal against any ejection or exclusion from the Club. Appeals must be made in writing to the HYP Director.

NOTES

The HYP team will endeavour to ensure that the HYP principles and rules are maintained within the club. It is however important to note that we have no authority to prevent any member leaving the premises should they wish to do so, and cannot be responsible for any arrangements for supervision following club closure.

There may be times when it is necessary to limit the number of members in the club, for example if there are insufficient leaders available to ensure overall safety within the club.

There may also be occasions when it is necessary or desirable to close the club at short notice earlier than the published times.
